Motion:

Discussion:

We are aware that Jane Wilcox of the Midwestern RAB has resigned and that that we have not heard from three people on the Western RAB for some time and I know that at least one of them (Daberath Ryan) has retired and most likely will not remain active.

Motion seconded, passed via email March 26, 2009.

Motion:

That Dolores be the 2YC3 representative on the SOCED task force and that she be the presenter as well. Motion seconded, passed via email April 13, 2009.

Motion:

That Ken Capps be accepted as the new chair of the Southern RAB. Motion seconded, passed via email July 7, 2009.

Motion:

That the Membership Chair provide a copy of the business addresses of members to Mettler. Motion seconded, passed via email September 1, 2009.

- I. The meeting was called to order Candice McCloskey at 5:30 pm.
- II. Minutes of Salt Lake City meeting March 19, 2009

Motion:

To accept the minutes from the 184th meeting in Salt Lake City. Motion seconded and passed unanimously.

III. Debriefing of 185th meeting

Program Chair Jason Jadin noted that there were 95 registrations – 93 preregistered, 2 registered at conference

16 paid membership fees by check, the number which paid membership fees by PayPal was unknown at the time of the meeting

It was noted that the Conference Planning Manual was detailed, but could use some updates. One example mentioned was that form letters may not be needed as much anymore, since most communication today is electronic. It was also noted that there could be more information in planning manual for exhibits coordinator.

Motion:

That Wake Tech Community College be accepted as host for the 190th conference. Motion seconded and passed unanimously.

Discussion:

Thanks to Mark Matthews for getting the ball rolling on this conference. A budget is still needed for the San Francisco meeting. Dolores will follow up.

V. Newsletter Report

Jim was not present at the meeting, but sent the Newsletter Report via email. (see Appendix)

Motion:

That there by a submission deadline of 90 days before a given conference date and a publishing/mailing deadline of 60 days before the conference date, pending approval of the newsletter editor. Motion seconded and passed unanimously.

VI. Treasurer Report

Kelly distributed copies of the Treasurer Report. (see Appendix)

Discussion:

Kelly distributed copies of the Treasurer Report. (see Appendix) Kelly has not yet received membership money from the Salt Lake City meeting. She will follow up with Neil Bastion to see if payment can be made soon.

Motion:

That the debt owed for membership fees and seed money by Baton Rouge Community College for the 180th Meeting be forgiven. Motion failed.

Discussion:

Michaeleen and Kelly will both follow up with Karen Stephens to see if the fees and seed money can be paid.

VII. College Sponsor Report

Kelly distributed copies of the College Sponsors Report. (see Appendix)

Discussion:

Kelly mentioned that she is a little behind where she'd like to be with college sponsors to date. She plans to send out a second notice for college sponsorship soon.

VIII. Industrial Sponsors Report

Discussion:

There are currently 27 sponsors. Suggestion was to make personal phone calls and ask if they would like to continue their sponsorship.

Most of the membership dues for industrial sponsors come due in September and October.

Duties for the industrial sponsors chair were sent to Jeff for updates shortly after the meeting in Salt Lake City.

IX. Membership Report

Discussion:

Membership stands at 414 as of August 20. Online registration accounted for 95 of these members.

It was noted that anyone paying membership fees for the 185th Meeting at Rochester would obtain membership for the 2010 calendar year.

There was a suggestion to update the member registration form on the web to distinguish between member name and payer name.

X. Webmaster Report

Discussion:

Andy asked that he be sent reminders if any portion of the website appears to be out of date.

It was noted that PayPal has been working well with fixed price payments, but is complicated for payments that may be variable such as conference fees.

There is an issue with the current web address redirection. Andy will work on getting this remediated soon.

The website needs to be updated to a consistent style sheet. Andy may look into hiring someone to do the job.

Motion:

Discussion:

There was some discussion to see if the 2YC₃, through the RAB Chairs, may be interested in modifying and submitting the ChemEd Bridges grant (Harry Ungar, Mary Boyd, David Brown, Tom Higgins) to NSF for funding travel to regional 2YC₃ meetings.

Discussion:

There will be a new SOCED task force on 2-year college activities. Dolores mentioned that she is not the official $2YC_3$ representative on the task force. After she was voted in by COCTYC (refer to the minutes above - motion passed via email April 13, 2009), she was informed that she was being asked to serve because she was on the previous task force. Candice then appointed Scott Donnelly (from the Western RAB) to be the $2YC_3$ rep.

Bill Mooney awards and 2YC₃ teaching awards were discussed, but there were no motions or action items.

XIII. Old business

Discussion:

There was some discussion on the need to update the conference planning manual. Lance and Michaeleen agreed to work on obvious updates in the near future.

Conference chairs may have the discretion to waive registration fees for keynote and banquet speakers. Motion seconded and approved unanimously.
